

Village of Alpha
Regular Meeting
November 4, 2019 @ 7pm

The regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Dean Kernan with the following board members present – Dennis Shannon, Tena Anseeuw, Becky Brown, Ron Medley, Mike Petrovich, and Alan Wendt.

Alan Wendt made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 7, 2019 meeting and Becky Brown seconded it. The motion carried with all ayes.

Tena Anseeuw made a motion to approve the bills for the month of October and Dennis Shannon seconded it. The motion carried with all ayes.

Jeff Kessinger gave the Public Works and Police report. Visu Sewer jetted and televised sewer main at South Park to 2nd St and removed corrosion build up in iron pipe under 1st St and under rail road tracks at Marlene addition. They also televised all 1960' of sewer main from the man hole just before rail road tracks in Marlene addition to the inlet at lagoon. Found clay sewer main in good shape. They did find several leaks at joints and at 3 manholes in Dave Cole's field. They will submit a proposal to repair these. Police report with 2 complaint, 3 special detail, 4 handed by officer, 45 traffic stops, 17 citations, 3 arrests, 1 assist other agency, and 31 building checks. Dennis Shannon made a motion to accept the Public Works and Police report and Tena Anseeuw seconded it. The motion carried with all ayes.

Steve Norberg gave the treasurer's report which showed the balance of \$369,418 in all accounts. Included in that balance is \$64,731 in the general fund, \$71,299 in motor/fuel and \$233,388 in water/sewer. There were only the normal receipts and bills for the month. Ron Medley made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Mike Petrovich seconded it. The motion carried with all ayes.

Police: Light bar for police car is here and needs to go to Macomb tomorrow the 5th to be installed. Tammy will be back on the 7th.

Community: Recycling went up to \$750 a quarter. Christmas Celebration is December 7th.

Water/Sewer: Paint stayed on the tower on the test, a verbal approval from the bank was done, the National rural water is letting us know.

In Old Business: Village Park is having a few issues with the title work. 2020 Census first mailing goes out in March, and have available jobs for our area.

In New Business: Auditors will be coming soon. Lot on 150 can be sold as an open bid, but will need to pass a ordinance.

Tena Anseeuw made a motion to adjourn and seconded by Alan Wednt. The motion carried with all ayes.
